# **Advanced Placement Courses**

**AP courses**: 10-point weight is added to individual semester course grades of 70 and above on the transcript. 10-point weight is also added to the final grade for each core content/world language dual enrollment course with a grade of 70 and above.

Class rank is determined by the numeric average for all subjects taken in grades 9-12. Class rank is reported at the end of the fall semester of the senior year. Valedictorian and Salutatorian is confirmed at the end of fall semester of the senior year.
